Emergency Engine Facility (PBR) (OAC 252:100-7-60.6.) – Effective September 15, 2016, a PBR is available for facilities that require a permit due to installation of an emergency engine subject to a federal standard. Please contact AQD about converting another permit type to this PBR.

2016 Permit by Rule (PBR) Emissions Inventory Reporting Requirements:

- All new facilities require an initial inventory.
- Facilities converting to a PBR may need to report a 2016 inventory; contact us for details.
- Annual Operating Fees are based on the most current inventory reported.
- Companies may choose to submit an annual inventory for a PBR facility even if an inventory is not required. Notify our office to have the PRB facilities included in Redbud.

Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) Emissions – Beginning with the 2014 emissions inventory, VOC emission factors and emission amounts are to be reported as **Total VOC** instead of **Volatile Organics (non-HAP)**. A Hazardous Air Pollutant (HAP) that is **also** a VOC should be calculated and reported uniquely if the emissions are above the reporting threshold. Many facilities are calculating and reporting their VOC emissions incorrectly using the outdated guidance. Please review calculation methods for deriving Total VOC emission amounts and report speciated HAPs as appropriate, exercising caution where a Total VOC emission factor explicitly excludes an individual HAP due to test method limitations.

Changes to Redbud – Internet Explorer is the only browser that fully supports Redbud. Compatibility view issues should be resolved for 2016.

Annual Operating Fees – Invoices for 2017 Annual Operating Fees will be mailed July 1, 2017. The fee for minor facilities is fixed at \$25.12 per ton of emissions of regulated air pollutant, and the fee for Title V facilities will be \$37.42 per ton.
