### **Water Use Advisory Lifted for the Oakview Water System**

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has announced that the water use advisory for the Oakview Water System, a subsidiary of the Oakview Water Corporation, has been lifted. The water is now safe for human consumption. DEQ staff have verified that there is adequate chlorine throughout the distribution system for disinfection, there is sufficient water pressure, and bacteriological samples indicated no bacteriological contamination.

DEQ is responsible for regulating more than 1,600 public water supplies in the State of Oklahoma. All public water supplies are required to regularly submit samples to DEQ for routine testing to ensure that water is safe for human consumption.
