Environmental Quality Board Meeting Scheduled for Lawton

Members of the Environmental Quality Board (EQB) of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) encourage residents of the Lawton area to attend a public forum scheduled for Wednesday, November 7, 2012. The public forum will be held following the regular business meeting of the Board. There is no way to estimate how long the business meeting will last, so there is no exact time for the start of the public forum.
