Strawn's Corner Water Use Advisory Issued

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has advised Strawn's Corner, located in Oklahoma County, not to use water in its soda fountain and to boil water for at least one minute that will be used in food preparation or dishwashing. Additionally, caution should be used in hand washing open wounds with water that has not been boiled. This advisory was issued due to the presence of *E. coli* in the water used by Strawn's Corner.

This water use advisory affects only Strawn's Corner and will remain in effect until corrective actions are completed and confirmation of bacteria-free samples has been achieved.

Federal law requires that consumers be notified when a public water supply exceeds certain maximum contaminant levels and might be harmful to the health of consumers.
