Water Use Advisory Lifted for City of Jenks

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has announced that the water use advisory for the City of Jenks, in Tulsa County, has been lifted. The water is now safe for human consumption. DEQ staff verified that there is adequate chlorine throughout the distribution system for disinfection and bacteriological samples indicated no bacteriological contamination.

DEQ is responsible for regulating more than 1,600 public water supplies in the State of Oklahoma. All public water supplies are required to regularly submit samples to DEQ for routine testing to ensure that water is safe for human consumption.
