DEQ will Host Open House to Discuss Smelter Materials on Kay County Roads and Bridges

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) invites you to a community open house scheduled from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., Thursday, February 28, 2013. The event will be held at the Newkirk Public Library, 116 North Maple Street, Newkirk, Oklahoma.

The event is open to the public and will focus on the investigation of smelter materials on Kay County roads and bridges. Discussions will include updates on field work in progress across more than 1,400 miles of county roads and plans for collecting samples to test for metals associated with smelter materials
