DEQ Schedules Meeting on Southeast Landfill Expansion

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has received an application from Southeast Landfill to expand the current landfill. There is a significant degree of public interest in this application; therefore, DEQ has scheduled a process meeting for Tuesday, March 5, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be held at the South OKC Council of Neighborhoods Building, located at 2200 SE 59th, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

At this meeting, DEQ will discuss the permitting process and provide information on how the public can participate in the permitting process. The meeting is open to the public, and all interested citizens are encouraged to attend.

Southeast Landfill has requested a permit modification that would increase the area for waste disposal. If this permit modification is approved, the types of waste allowed at the landfill would remain unchanged.
