DEQ Announces Lawn Mower Exchange Event

The Air Quality Division of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, in collaboration with OSU-OKC Farmers Market and Black and Decker, will hold a lawn mower exchange event on Saturday, April 25 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. for Oklahoma City metro-area residents in the following counties: Canadian, Cleveland, Grady, Lincoln, Logan, McClain and Oklahoma. The event will be held at the OSU-OKC Farmer's Market, 400 N. Portland Avenue in Oklahoma City.

At the event, citizens can exchange used, gasoline-powered lawn mowers that are in working condition for a \$100 voucher towards the purchase of a new, electric lawn mower. There are 100 vouchers available, which can be redeemed at the Black & Decker service center, located at 8507 S. Western Ave in Oklahoma City. In addition to the voucher, Black and Decker will offer 20% off on mowers purchased through the Lawnmower Exchange Program.

Vouchers are limited to one per household. All gasoline mowers for exchange must be operational and drained of all gasoline and oil.
