Boil Order Issued for the Town of Jones City Public Water Supply

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has advised the Town of Jones City Public Water Supply (PWS), a community water supply located in Oklahoma County, to inform users of its drinking water to use water that has been brought to a full, rolling boil for at least one minute, bottled water, or water from another acceptable source for consumption, use in food preparation, dishwashing and brushing teeth. This order was issued due to the presence of *E. coli*.

Consumers of the water system will be notified when the water is considered safe for human consumption. Federal law requires that consumers be notified when a public water supply exceeds certain maximum contaminant levels and might be harmful to the health of consumers.
