DEQ Announces Winners of New Specialty License Plate

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is excited to announce the [two winners of the specialty tag voting](#). The public chose the American Bison grazing in an Oklahoma prairie and the Oklahoma sunset over a field of flowers. The specialty plates will be available for purchase later this year.

Voting began on January 8 and ran until January 19. Over 5,500 votes were cast during that time. The winning designs were announced on DEQ's Facebook page on January 22.

Each specialty plate costs \$38, with \$24 going to fund DEQ's Environmental Education Tag Grant Program, which provides money to Oklahoma schools for environmentally-focused projects.
