Environmental Quality Board Meeting Scheduled for Broken Arrow

Members of the Environmental Quality Board (EQB) of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) encourage residents of northeastern Oklahoma to attend a public forum scheduled for Thursday, November 13, 2014. The public forum will be held following the regular business meeting of the Board. There is no way to estimate how long the business meeting will last, so there is no exact time for the start of the public forum. Both the meeting and public forum will be held at Northeastern State University at 3100 E. New Orleans St. in Broken Arrow. The regular business meeting will start at 9:30 a.m. The Environmental Quality Board is the rulemaking authority for DEQ.
